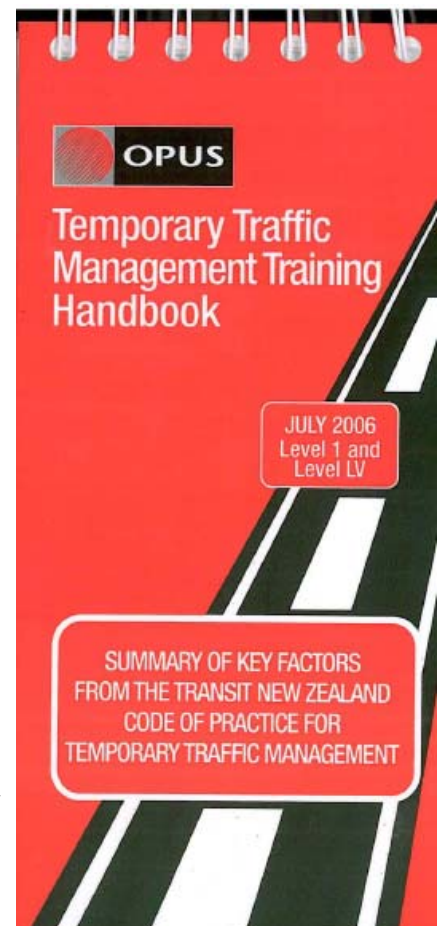

It is not intended to be used in place of nor supersede the Code and is made available on the basis that all users are conversant with the Code and hold current qualification as prescribed by the Code.

They must also comply with the requirements of:

- the Code
- the Manual of Traffic Signs and Markings
- Health and Safety in Employment Act and Regulations
- all legislation relevant to the works

We advise users to keep abreast of all revisions of the Code and relevant legislation, to comply with requirements of the particular Road Controlling Authority, and to exercise sound engineering judgement

Transit New Zealand and Roading New Zealand have reviewed this publication and they endorse its use for training purposes. The contents have been checked and as at the time of publication it represents the philosophy and requirements of the COPTTM. However, the Transit NZ COPTTM document always takes precedent and the latest version should be referred to in full.
